Course Requirements/Grading System One (1) written assignment will be required which entails finding an article pertaining to medication errors from a current (within 3 years) professional healthcare magazine or journal. A brief synopsis of the article is to be submitted. The journal must be cited in APA format or no credit will be given for the assignment. This synopsis will be counted as a test grade.

The average of unit tests is 65%, assigned homework is 5% and medication administration check-off will be 5% of the course grade. The comprehensive final will be 25% of the final grade.
