Course Learning Outcomes:

Learning Outcomes – Upon successful completion of this course, students will:

- 1. Students will develop the ability to read all types of rhythms.
- 2. Students will demonstrate a better understanding of the structure of major and minor scales as well as various church modes. Student will develop understanding of scale patterns used in jazz literature.
- 3. Students will develop technical proficiency on their instrument.
- 4. Student will perform assigned pieces of music that show their abilities at one public performance each semester.

Methods of Assessment:

- 1. Students will work on various assigned pieces of jazz literature that involves various rhythmic patterns, syncopation, and mixed meter. Performance will be assessed by instructor observation.
- 2. Students will perform standard jazz literature that incorporates various uses of major/minor scales, church modes and jazz scales incorporated into their music. Performance will be assessed by instructor observation.
- 3. Students will perform jazz music from various levels of difficulty. Performance will be assessed by instructor observation.
- 4. Students will perform at least one public concert for the college and general public semester.
