The three-story building includes 145,000-square-feet. Wharton County Junior College occupies about 100,000 square feet. The new building offers WCJC about 20,000 more feet than its previous location in Sugar Land.

In addition to meeting the needs of Fort Bend County's growing population, housing both the University of Houston System at Sugar Land and WCJC on the same campus helps each institution to devote more funds to educational activities rather than to separate infrastructure. The joint facility also allows students to fulfill most all of their educational needs on a single campus that offers lower-level and upper-level courses.

Wharton County Junior College's Sugar Land campus offers academic transfer courses, associate degrees, and continuing education courses. In the future, the WCJC campus will offer an Associate of Applied Science Degree in Nursing. With the completion of the WCJC associate degree nursing program, students will be qualified to take the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses. If the students choose to continue their education, they may transition into the University of Houston Bachelor of Science in Nursing Degree program.

The new building includes more than 50 new classrooms, a performance hall/auditorium, computer, science, and nursing skills laboratories, faculty offices, a bookstore a weight room, an aerobics room, and a student lounge.
