



Welcome to Wharton County Jr. College Online Class access Instruction

Student Instructions:

To access your classes: Login by entering your student ID **WITH OUT** the @ sign as your User ID, enter the same number for your Password and click Login. If this is your first time to login, it will ask if you want to change your password. We do recommend you change your password, and keep it secure. After you login, you will be connected to your Blackboard/WebCT page which will list all of your classes. From the My Blackboard/WebCT page you will be able to see campus announcements, campus bookmarks such as the Library, a space for personal bookmarks, a personal calendar that can and will keep track of all deadlines, and other features. To select the class you want to work in click on the title, and begin.

If you are a Virtual College of Texas student you will need to use the ID Number issued to you in the E-mail from Barbara Watson. This number will be for both the ID and Password. Please note the "@" sign should be omitted.

To learn how to use Blackboard/WebCT: Enter student as the User ID, and student as the Password, and click on Login. From this screen you will see a class called Student WebCT 6.0 Tutorial. Select this class by clicking on the Title, and enter the tutorial. This tutorial is to familiarize the student with not only the tools available, but the possible class arrangements that may be utilized by WCJC instructors.
