In this class the students will learn and demonstrate skills needed for working in the hospitality industry, including effective interview techniques, social skills pragmatics for successful workplace communications with coworkers, supervisors, and customers; and set up service styles for banquets and catering. The students will learn the importance of providing prompt, courteous, and friendly guest service for the hospitality industry and will demonstrate skills for such service. The instruction will be differentiated according to skills and supports needed for each student. A teacher summary of student performance will be provided at the end of the course. This is not a college credit class; however each student will receive a certificate of participation.

Basic computer skills and assessment will be scheduled.

A component of the course will include basic assembly and repair of items in the home.
